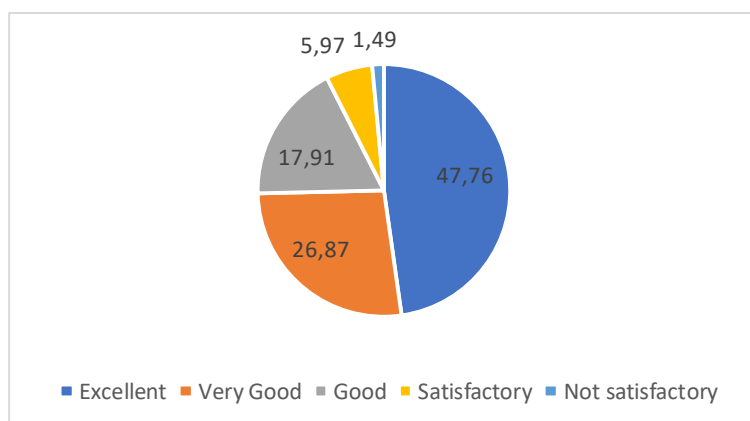
Students Satisfaction Survey

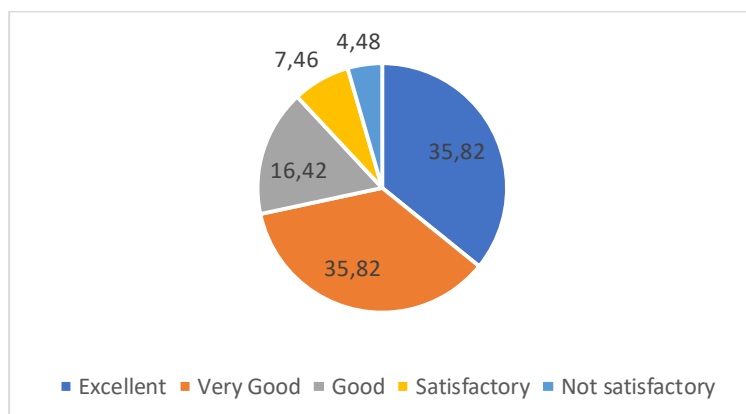

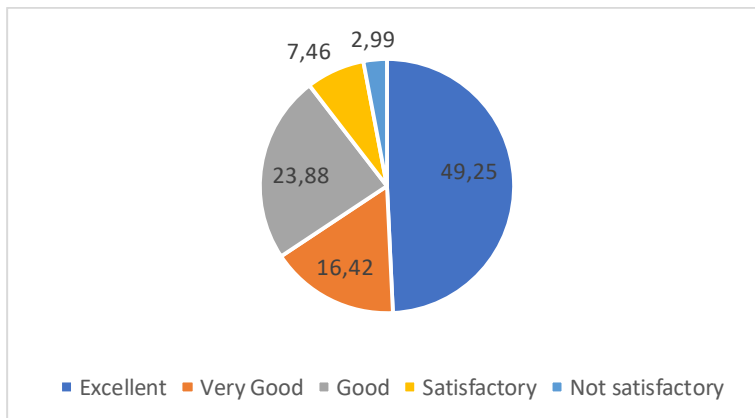
1. Curriculum design promotes to pursue research/ higher studies



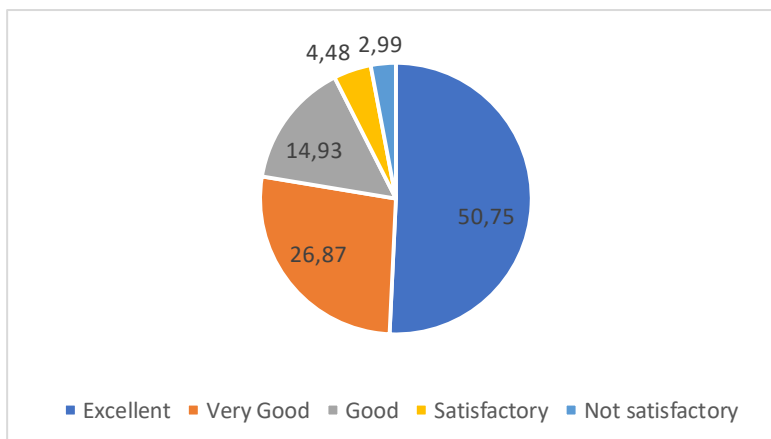
