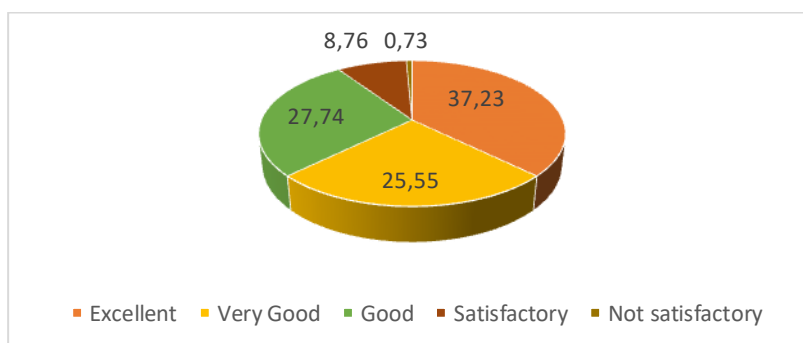
## **Students Satisfaction Survey**

**2016-2017**

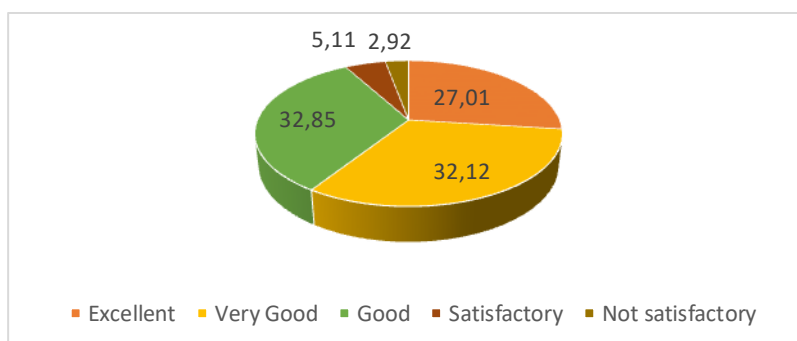
